Technicians Already in the Profession (Community College, Career College, On-the-Job Trained)

Step 1 Certification Exam OR PEBC Evaluating Exam		> PEBC starts offering Evaluating Exam (considered equivalent to OCP certification exam)	> PEBC offers Evaluating exam ongoing (twice annually) > Jan. 1 2012 is the deadline for current technicians to complete Step 1.
Step 2 Bridging Education Program	> First classroom delivery of one course at accredited Colleges	> Satellite locations become available > On-line course delivery begins > Classroom delivery of additional courses begins	> Program is fully available and offered regularly throughout the year > Additional satellite locations established as needed > Jan. 1 2015 is the deadline to complete Bridging

Technicians New to the Profession (Graduate from a CCAPP accredited program)

Step 1 CCAPP accredited education programs	> 7 Ontario education programs achieve accreditation status > CCAPP invites accreditation applications annually > Additional education programs achieve accreditation		
Step 2 Structured Practical Training (SPT)	> Program in development	> Program is finalized, details released, preceptors identified and trained	> SPT starts for CCAPP graduates > SPT available ongoing for graduates of CCAPP accredited programs

All Technicians Pursuing Registration (after completing steps 1 and 2)

Step 3 PEBC Entry-to-practice exam	> Exam in development > OCP calls for volunteers to sit the pilot exam	> Candidates selected for the pilot exam	> Pilot exam administered by PEBC (160 candidates only) > Research analysis of the pilot completed, revisions made if necessary	> PEBC finalizes the exam and begins to accept applications	> Part 1 – Written exam begins (to be offered twice annually, and ongoing) > Part 2 – Performance exam begins (to be offered twice annually, and ongoing)
Step 4 Jurisprudence Exam	> Exam in development		> OCP offers JP seminar > OCP administers the first JP exam.	> OCP offers the JP exam four times annually > OCP offers JP seminars	
Step 5 Complete the Registration Process	> OCP prepares registration processes		> OCP starts to register technicians who have completed all requirements	> OCP registers eligible technicians ongoing	

The Registration Requirements and Timelines are consistent with the Proposed Registration Regulation and are dependent on government approval by fall 2009.
